NIAGARA FALLS, ONTARIO Including African American Heritage Tour

5 Days - 4 Nights

- Day 1 After arrival in enchanting Niagara Falls, Ontario you will be given a brief orientation of what awaits you in the days ahead. After settling into your hotel, you will be taken to dinner at a popular restaurant. Return to your hotel for a chance to acquaint yourself with the surroundings at your leisure for the rest of the evening.
- Day 2 After breakfast, you will go on a **full day tour of the Niagara area**. Your tour begins with the famous "Maid of the Mist" boat ride aboard the **Hornblower**; bring your camera for a picture of the Falls from the water. Afterwards, you will visit **Niagara's Floral Clock**, which has three hands, a changeable face, and is covered by 25,000 plants. Continue to beautiful **Niagara-on-the-Lake**, which is located where the Niagara River meets Lake Ontario, across from Youngstown, NY. Many of the town's first inhabitants were Loyalists who fled the U.S. during the and immediately the American Revolution. After your tour, enjoy a delicious **dinner at the Skylon Tower** which overlooks the Falls.
- Day 3 Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then travel to Hamilton, Ontario where you visit the Royal Botanical Gardens and Dundurn Castle. The Royal Botanical Gardens are Canada's largest, with over 2,400 acres of gardens and nature sanctuary. Dundurn is a 40-room neo-classical castle that was completed in 1835 and featured the latest conveniences of gas lighting and running water. After your visits, return to Niagara Falls for dinner at another popular restaurant.
- Breakfast begins your day that will take you to St. Catharines for a **Black History Tour**. The City of St. Catharines was an important sight for early abolitionists and formerly enslaved people escaping slavery through the Underground Railroad. Harriet Tubman lived in St. Catharines for 10 years where she worked as an abolitionist and helped former enslaved people adjust to their new life. Your first stop will be the **BME Church**, then continue to several **Underground Railroad sites**. Afterwards, you will visit **Chocolate F/X** for a tour and sampling of their delicious chocolates. Your day will end with another delicious **dinner** at a popular restaurant, followed by a few hours at the **Niagara Fallsview Casino** where you can try your luck at gambling.
- Day 5 Following breakfast, check out and depart for home with fond memories of Niagara Falls.
